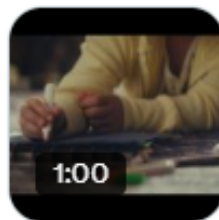

Washington – Win Without War launches new digital billboard advertising military know-your-rights resources to troops stationed at Ft. Bragg, North Carolina.

"In response to the Trump administration's authoritarian threat to invoke the Insurrection Act and deploy active duty troops to back up ICE's murderous rampage through the streets of Minneapolis, Win Without War is reaching out directly to the soldiers at risk of being implicated in ICE's crimes to make sure they know where to turn if they receive unlawful orders.

"Win Without War has posted a new digital billboard near Ft. Bragg, NC advertising NotWhatYouSignedUpFor.org, a website that connects servicemembers with resources on responding to unlawful orders and understanding their rights while in uniform. This week, the Trump administration ordered troops stationed at Ft. Bragg and Ft. Wainwright, Alaska to prepare to deploy to Minneapolis.

"We are proud to continue to highlight the work of principled organizations experienced in counseling service members on how to handle unlawful orders, including About Face, the GI Rights Hotline, and the National Lawyers Guild Military Law Task Force.

"This campaign began in September in Washington, DC, and has since expanded to Ft. Bragg, Camp Lejeune, Chicago, Memphis, and U.S. Southern Command (SOUTHCOM) headquarters in Doral, Florida.

"As the Trump administration puts our servicemembers at elevated legal, moral, and even physical risk with illegal overseas operations and unnecessary domestic deployments, it is more important than ever that troops know their rights and understand their options for serving honorably. We want our troops to know someone has their back – because the Trump administration doesn't.

"The new digital billboard is located near: 1939 Skibo Rd, Fayetteville, NC."

Members were involved with Bernie Sanders campaign and are continuing their activism in Our Revolution, Swing Left, **Indivisible**, Working Families Party, statewide groups like the New Virginia Majority and local Democratic Party groups and 2018 electoral campaigns.

JESUS RAUL PEREZ MENDEZ, chief of the Department of the Community Abroad of the Cuban Institute of Friendship with the Peoples (ICAP) and captain of the Cuban Directorate General of Intelligence (DGI) defected on July 13, 1983, and informed the following:

That the America Department of the Cuban Communist Party (DA), the ICAP, and the DGI control the ANTONIO MACEO BRIGADE (BAM), CASA DE LAS AMERICAS, CIRCULO DE CULTURA CUBANA, CENTER FOR CUBAN STUDIES, VENCEREMOS BRIGADE (VB), NATIONAL LAWYERS GUILD, NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF BLACK LAWYERS, PARTIDO SOCIALISTA PUERTORRIQUEÑO-NYC, AND THE COMMUNIST PARTY USA. They are all controlled by ALFREDO GARCIA ALMEIDA, chief of the North American Section of the Americas Department and former political counselor at the Cuban Mission to the United Nations in NYC, with the exception of CASA DE LAS AMERICAS, which is controlled by HECTOR MANUEL ZAYAS QUIALA, of the DGI, and second secretary of the Cuban Mission NYC.

The leaders of the BAM and the VB receive training of indoctrination in ideology, psychology, organization, propaganda techniques, interview techniques, and intelligence gathering. The groups are financed by illegal commercial activities of narcotics. The BAM serves for purposes of propaganda and intelligence. ANDRES GOMEZ, MARIANA GASTON ROCHE, ARMANDO D. GARCIA, and MANUEL R. GOMEZ CAINOS are controlled by the DGI. The ICAP considers ALBOR RUIZ SALAZAR unstable. ARMANDO D. GARCIA is a homosexual and MARIANA GASTON a prostitute.
