➡ Later, Prokofiev would go on to co-found and preside over the Strategic Culture Foundation (SCF).

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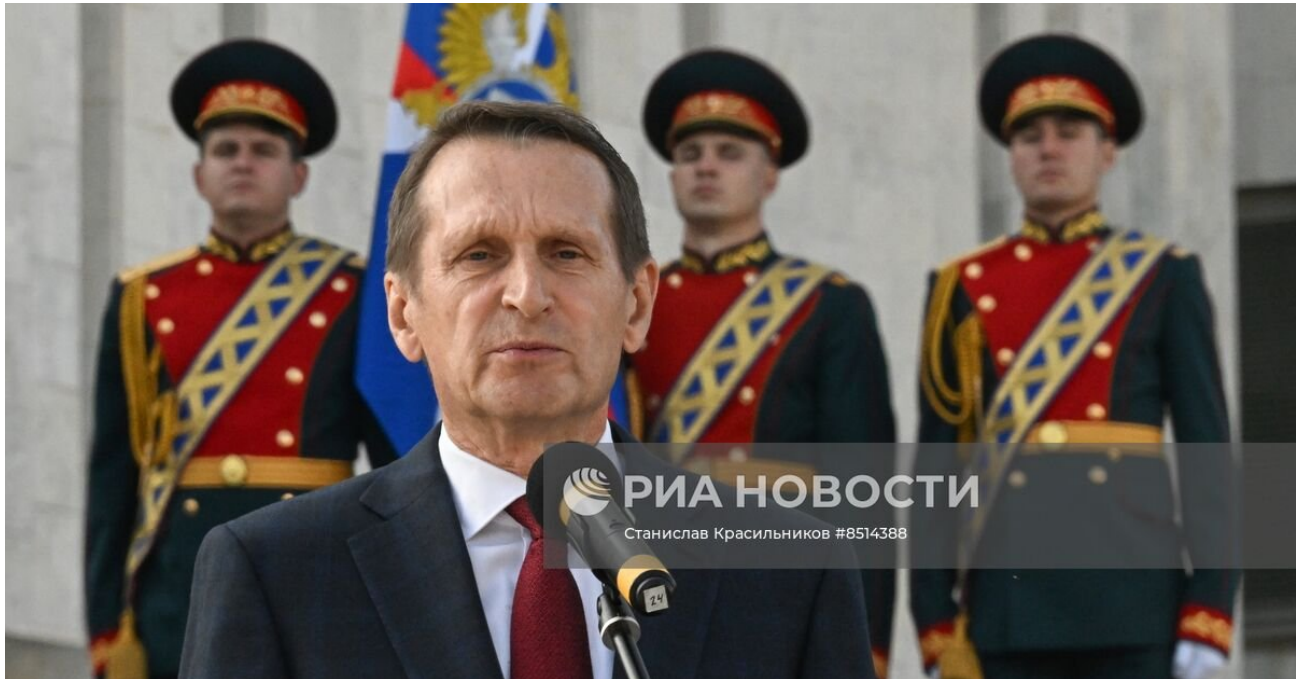

➡ SCF is controlled by Russia's Foreign Intelligence Service (SVR) and Сергей Нарышкин/Sergey Naryshkin is the director of the SVR.

➡ Naryshkin also has a long history of service to the Communist Party going back to the Komsomol then later the KGB.



➡ On 9/11 of 2023 (anniversary of Феликс Дзержинский/Felix Dzerzhinsky's birth), Naryshkin delivered a speech at SVR HQ for the ceremony of the opening of the new Dzerzhinsky sculpture monument.

➡ Dzerzhinsky was the head of the domestic state security services of S.U.



- ➡ Under Dzerzhinsky's--"sword and shield" of the revolution--Cheka, brilliant operations were initiated to demoralize and ultimately crush the resistance.
- ➡ One of these was called Operation Trust. The Cheka set up fake anti-Bolshevik and Monarchist organizations

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as bait to draw in the enemies of the Communists into a trap and to control the opposition from Moscow.

➡ The Cheka went as far as arming resistance groups against itself and blowing up its own police stations to convince dissidents that anti-Bolsheviks

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had some power inside the Soviet Union.

➡ Trust ran for the better part of the 1920s, and near the end of the decade Moscow began executing key dissidents it had caught in this trap and lured back to Moscow.

- ➡ Some still believe in the disinformation spread by the KGB and their perceptions of reality are partly derived from KGB disinfo.

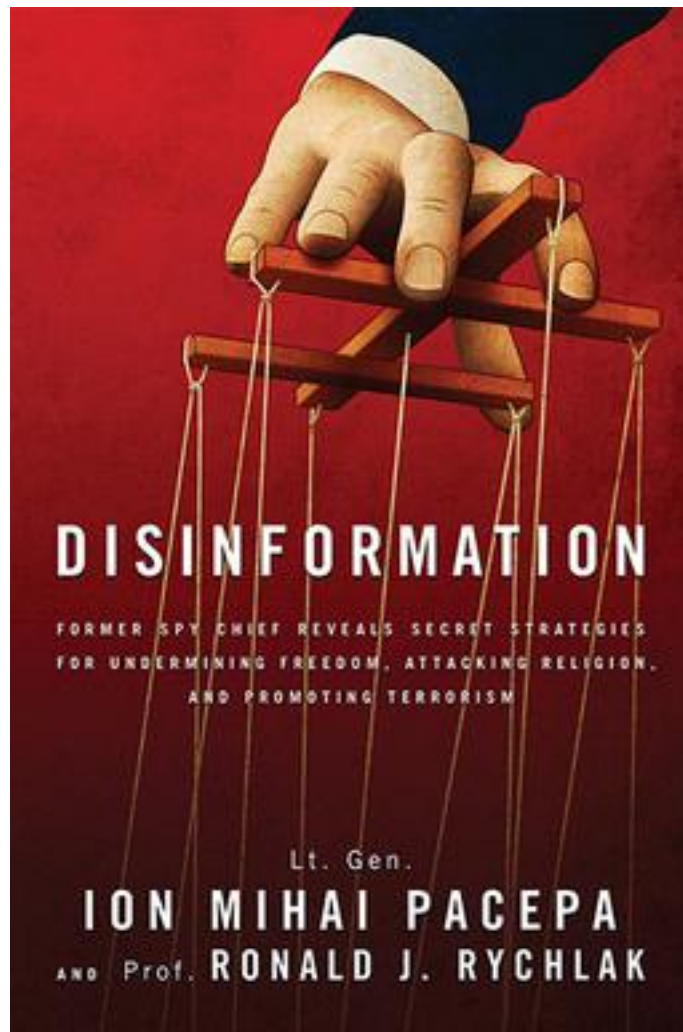

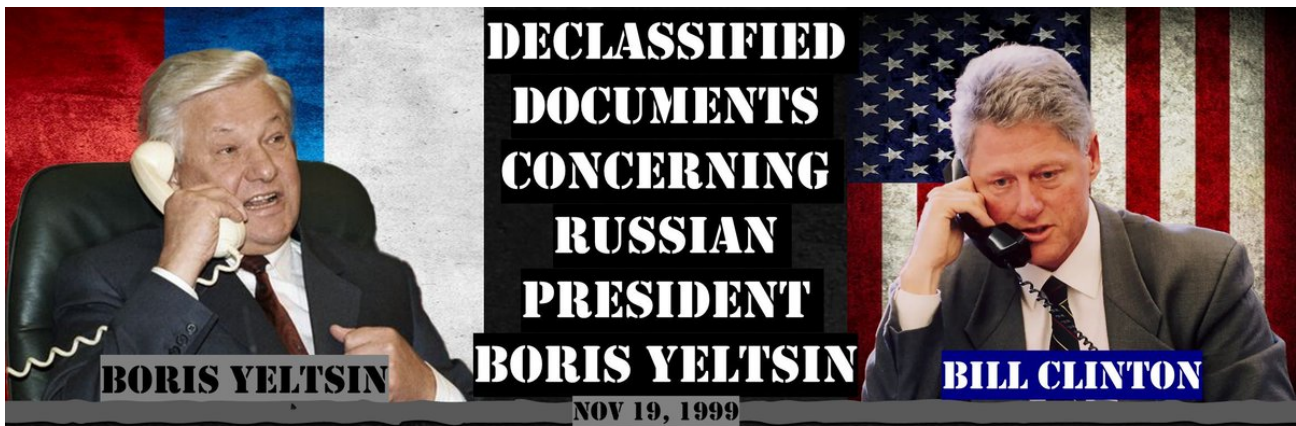

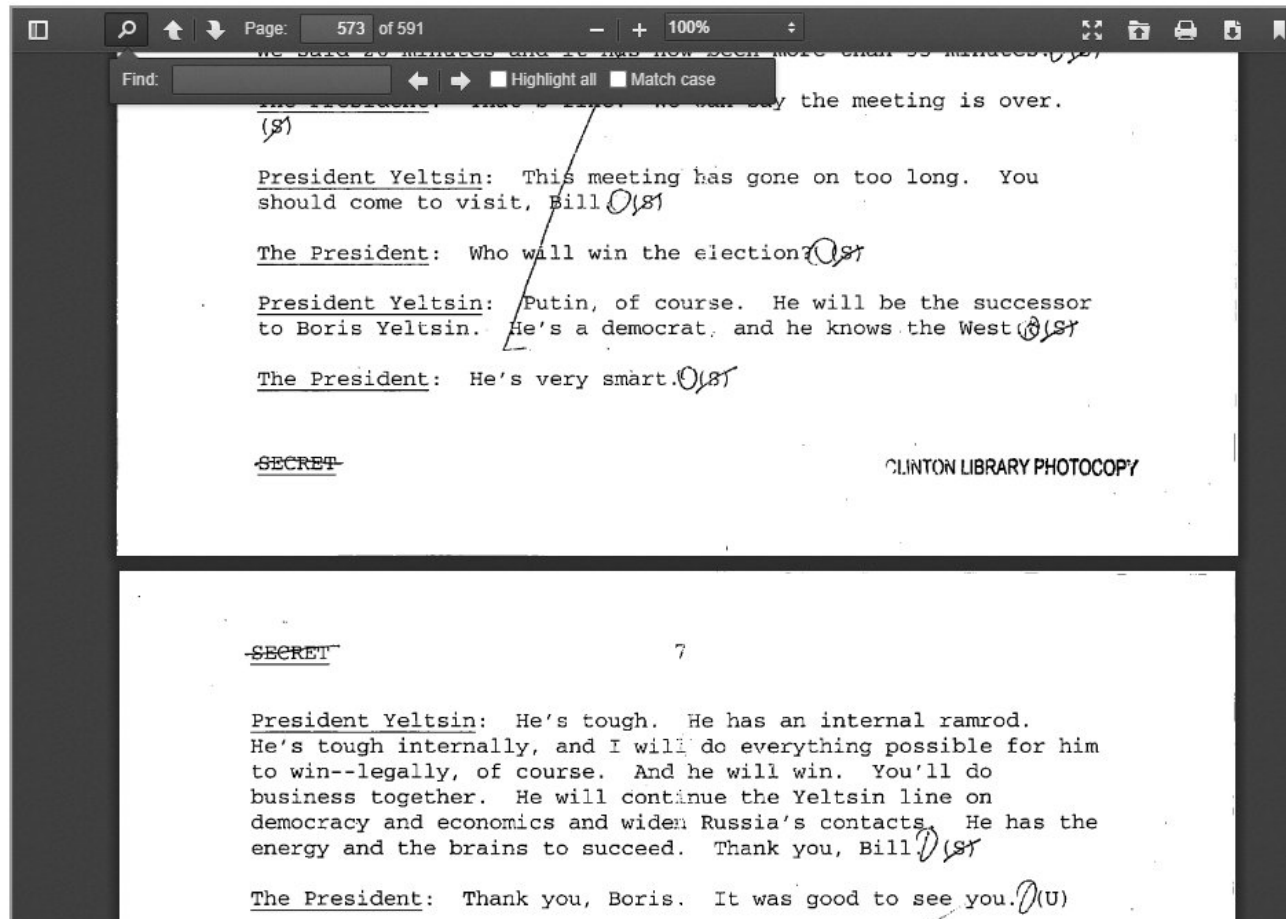

Speech by the President of American University in Moscow **Edward Lozansky** on the round table "Five principles of Russian foreign policy: multipolarity as inevitability"

Firstly, I want to thank Vladimir Ivanovich Dobrenkov for this meeting. The fact is that it was here, at the social faculty of Moscow State University, that American University began. 18 years ago, when we were all very naive and believed that with the collapse of communism, Russia would be met with hugs in the West, this was the first idea of – the creation of American University, and everything happened here on the second floor of this building. The university developed and then became part of a large international university. Vladimir Ivanovich, thank you.

Alexander Gellievich Dugin said that the Americans are pragmatists, all kinds of philosophical reasoning are far from them, they need to talk about more specific things; but here are the neocons, whom now, in general, are scolded, they are more likely ideologists. To some extent, they resemble Marxists who believe in some ideas.

I want to add that there are also ordinary conservatives to which I consider myself. These are people like Ron Reagan, Margaret Thatcher ... I would add the names of Patrick Buchanan, Paul Wairik, Donald Duvain and others. These are the pillars of American conservatism. And I must say that of those who carefully read the American press or articles on the Internet, many notice that these conservatives, right-wing anti-communists, of course, first of all, unexpectedly took a position, I would not say the pro-Russian, – but at least they say that what happened in Georgia is the fault of the United States. And before, these people understood that it was better to have Russia on its side. There were a huge number of delegations here, some of which I managed to organize, where they called for Russia to join NATO, to actively participate in the creation of the missile defense system which would be much more effective if Russia and America worked together. And in this regard, I would say that Russia has a more favorable position than the Soviet Union, which relied in America on radical leftists, on the Communist Party, which had no influence in American society, and therefore all these means that were invested in support of the communist movement, were thrown into the wind.

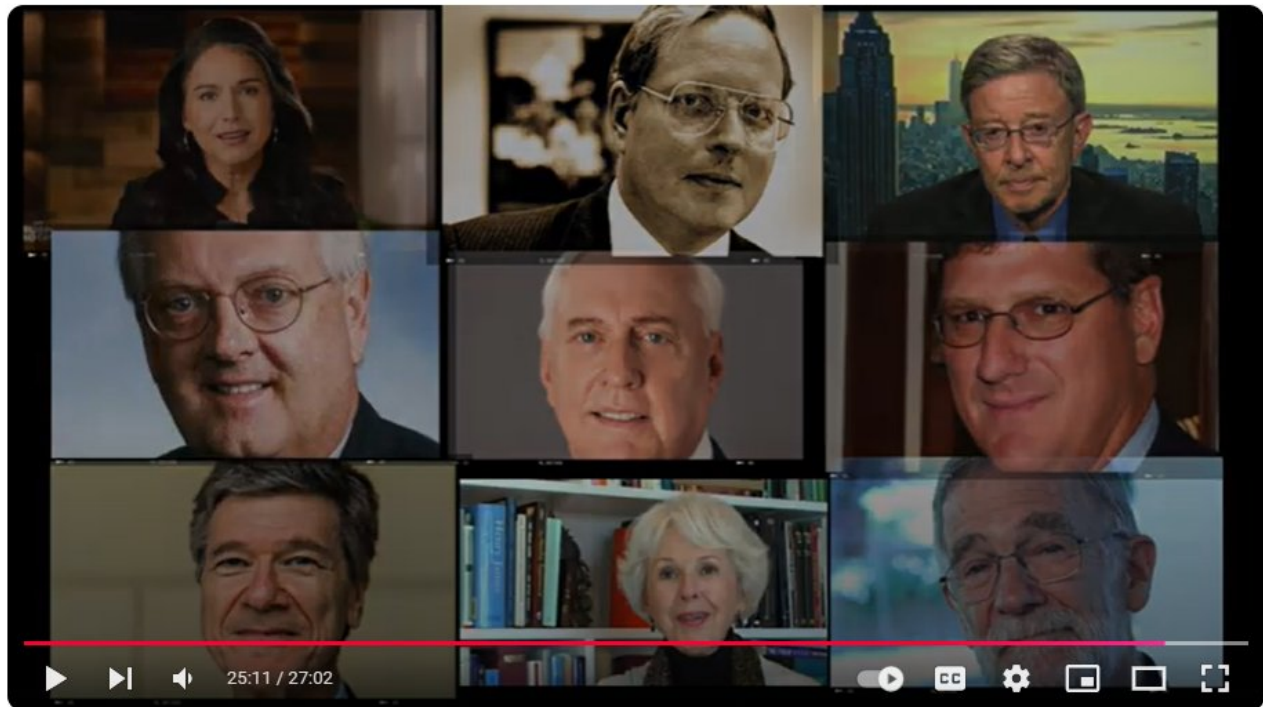

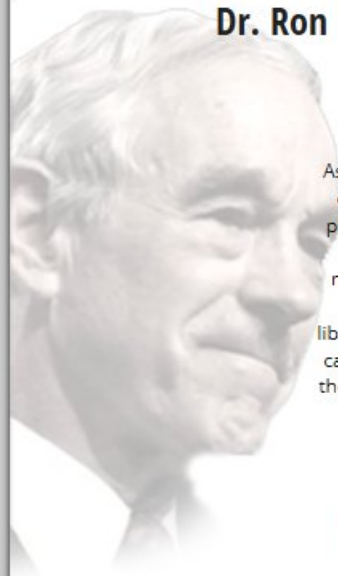

prominence after the coup), the coup was unsuccessful and *Den'* was renamed to *Zavtra* (Tomorrow) a couple years later after the 1993 October Coup at the Russian White House.³²⁴ According to Dugin, the day the Soviet flag lowered over the Kremlin, December 25, 1991, was the day he became a Soviet man forever. In his own words:³²⁵

I realized that I had become, totally, irreversibly a Soviet man. Fatally, triumphally Soviet. This after so many tortured years of implacable hatred for my surroundings, for the 'Sovdep', and following my radical, uncompromising national nonconformism. Of course I always hated the West as well. . . But in that August, (despite much conscious effort) all the internal logic of my soul was on the side of the Emergency Committee.

While Dugin was working at *Den'*, Prokhanov helped him get a position as adjunct professor at the Academy of the General Staff of the Russian military which was headed by an acquaintance of Prokhanov's: Colonel-General Igor Rodionov—former General of the 40th Army in Afghanistan (that Prokhanov was at one time attached to) who later was appointed the Russian minister of defense in 1996-1997.³²⁶ Starting in the early 1990s, Dugin taught inside the

Department of Strategy at the academy which was headed by Lieutenant General H.P. Kolokotov.³²⁷ Dugin marks this period as the beginning of the Russian school of geopolitics and General Kolokotov remarked that the theory of geopolitics would “serve as a mighty ideological foundation for preparing a new command.”³²⁸ Dugin's European associates traveled to Russia to lecture on the subject, including inside the academy to the Russian military (and at least one of these meetings had seven generals in attendance).³²⁹

Dugin cites the first geopolitical texts of the Russian school geopolitics: In his book *Mysteries of Eurasia* (published under his own publishing house *Arktogeya* in 1991) was “Continent Russia”

This approach has several advantages for Russia:

- it gives increased circulation to what would otherwise be fringe voices that suit Russian propaganda goals;
- Russia deflects responsibility by obscuring its sponsorship of the site; and
- the individuals and conspiracy theorists they publish communicate in local idioms and understand their home audiences well.

The Strategic Culture Foundation and the Russian State

SCF was founded in 2005.¹ Originally it only published its journal in Russian. In September 2010, the online journal began to also appear in English.² This marked SCF's debut as an instrument for disinformation and propaganda on the international stage.

While SCF's online journal makes every effort to appear independent, it is directed by Russia's Foreign Intelligence Service (SVR) and closely affiliated with the Russian Ministry of Foreign Affairs.³ There is no mention of this affiliation on SCF's English-language website, nor of any link to Russia—including the fact that SCF publishes in Russian.⁴ However, *International Affairs*, the flagship journal of the Russian Ministry of Foreign Affairs since 1922, states on its website that SCF is its partner.⁵

SCF's president is Yuri Prokofiev, who was Moscow Party Chief from 1989 to 1991 and a Soviet Politburo Member.⁶ Prokofiev is also one of the founders of the "Russian Organization for Assistance to Special Services and Law Enforcement Authorities" (ROSSPO).⁷ According to its website, ROSSPO works closely with Russian security services to support the policies of the Russian state, facilitate cooperation between state institutions and civil society, and ensure the social protection of the employees of intelligence services and law enforcement authorities.⁸

SCF is controlled by the SVR's Directorate MS (Measures) and created false and unsubstantiated narratives concerning U.S. officials involved in the 2020 U presidential election. It publishes conspiracy theorists, giving them a broader platform to spread disinform while trying to obscure the Russian origins of the journal so that readers may be more likely to trust the so

The GRU operates **InfoRos**. InfoRos calls itself a news agency but is primarily run by the GRU's T2nd Main Intelligence Information Center (GRITs). GRITs is a unit within Russia's Information Operations Troops, which identified as Russia's military force for conducting cyberespionage, influence, and offensive cyber operations.

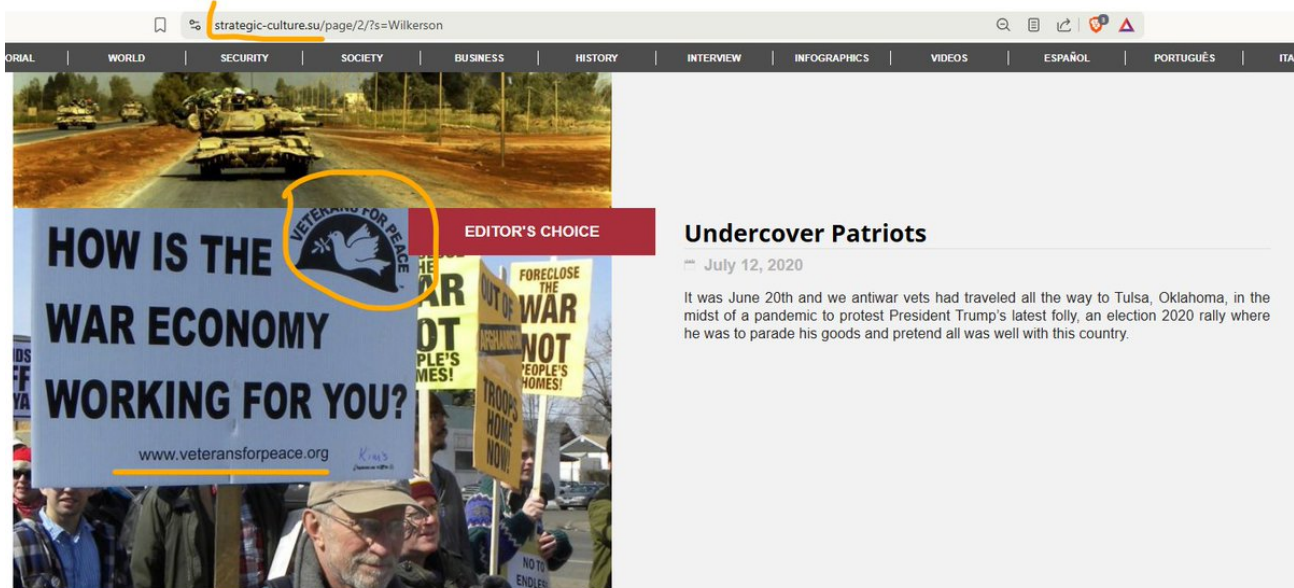
